

DISABLED PERSONS POLICY

High Plains Recreation Assoc. decrees to honor and allow a recognized federal, medically-disabled person to continue as part of a family membership plan when over the age of 18 years of age. The following guidelines of the Social Security Administration for receiving disabled benefits shall apply in order to qualify for the HPRAI exception benefits:

- A. Must be an unmarried son or daughter age 18 or older with a disability that started before age 22 and is continuing.
- B. The exception may continue as long as the person is disabled pursuant to the Social Security Disability Determination Service (“DDS”).
- C. Disability under Social Security is based on the inability to work.
- D. The individual has limited income.
- E. The individual lives with the parents.
- F. The parents contribute substantial support to the individual.
